NZCA ANNUAL CONFERENCE 11-12 JUNE 2016

The annual National Conference was held in Wellington over the weekend of 11-12 June. Hawkes Bay delegates were Jenny Too, Ray Ching, Mina Ching, Sook Hua Lee, David Xie, John Chen and James Guan.

National President Meng Foon welcomed Guest Speakers

*Saturday :- Chinese Embassy :Vice-Ambassador Qu and Consular Liu. Mr Qu commented on the bilateral relationship between NZ and PR of China.

* Jo Coughlan- co-chair from NZ Chinese Language week (12-18 September), who together with Raymond Huo, are working towards promoting Chinese and engaging local community in learning .

* Sunday - Taipei Economic and Cultural Office (TECO) -Mr David Wu, TECO Representative addressed the Conference. His talk included Taiwan's new president, its economic performance, improvement in cross-strait relations and outlined TECO's cultural services.

Parliamentary Chinese New Year Celebration- NZCA has been asked by Government to compile annually a list of guests for Prime Minister to invite to this event. Branches to submit VIP names.

Following the inaugural successes of this year,

NZCA to annually attend Waitangi Day celebrations at the Treaty Grounds with total of 8 officially invited delegates, each from different branches. Names to be submitted to Head Office early for sending on to Government for security clearance.

NZCA Branches encouraged to annually attend Anzac Day services locally to represent Chinese.

2017 NZCA Easter Tournament to be held in Christchurch 14-17 April. A prizegiving ceremony dinner (instead of a Ball) to be held at a restaurant with dance to follow. Events to include a fishing event, and special sporting events. All Branches invited to send teams.

NZCA agreed in principle to help fund towards the construction of a Chinese Garden in Wellington.

SS Ventnor report

Liu Shueng Wong updated regarding SS Ventnor on-going project which is now called "Wandering with the Ancestors". 8th, 9th & 10th of April 2017 is the launch date of the current event - a Tourism Trail in conjunction with NZ Tourism and NZ Heritage Trust. LOCAL ELECTIONS

Local elections are held once every three years. The elections are for city and district councils, regional councils and District Health Boards. In some parts of New Zealand, elections will also be held for local and community boards, licensing trusts and some other organisations. The Electoral Commission does not run these elections, but is responsible for voter enrolment. All local elections are held by postal vote. Voting papers are posted to all voters who are enrolled about a month before voting starts. You must be enrolled to vote in local elections. Only people who are correctly enrolled will receive their voting papers in the mail. Our HB Local elections voting period will be between 16 September – 8 October 2016.
